 - Courts' workload analysis performed
 - Case management tools for backlogged cases analysis performed
 - ICT tools
 - Memoranda of Understanding

 - Aligned with Action Plan for CH 23 and Judicial Functional Review recommendations
 - Comprises measures from earlier Unified BLR Plan and Special Program for Backlog Enfocement Cases

Support to the SCC Case Law Harmonization Activities

- Implementation of the new Law on Enforcement and Security through four round tables for judges of basic and commercial courts – these served for collecting disputed legal issues to which SCC will dedicate a special session during Annual Judges' Conference, Oct. 9-12, 2016
- Continued implementation of the Appellate Courts' Joint Meetings' Plan







- Study visit to The Netherlands for SCC justices and staff
 - Case-law issues in local and international courts
 - Access to case law database
 - Rules of anonymization/pseudonymization
 - Backlog prevention in Dutch courts









- Statistical processing and reporting for SCC, appellate courts and larger basic courts
- Performance measurement and management for SCC and appellate courts
- Identification of most common issues that courts have in preparation of statistical reports requested by SCC and Appellate courts.







- Workshops for SCC and appellate courts advisors on the recent ECHR case-law with skills training on interpreting ECHR decisions in domestic jurisprudence
- Study visit for case-law departments' advisors to Croatia and Slovenia to be focused on:
 - Challenges and best practices in case-law harmonization
 - Tools on decision exchange

- Continuous training of SCC and Appellate court statisticians and ICT staff in using advanced Excel features through showcase based on standardized report
