Assignment Description

The World Bank intends to finance the assignment/services described below under the Serbia Multi-Donor Trust Fund for Justice Sector Support (MDTF-JSS). The Republic of Serbia is making efforts to accelerate its EU integration. The World Bankexecuted MDTF-JSS aims to facilitate Serbia's EU integration process and provide analytical, policy and capacity-building support to its justice sector reform and modernization efforts. As a first step, baseline information will be collected using surveys and other information gathering techniques to benchmark Serbia's performance on different aspects of service delivery relevant to the justice sector.
